Literacy

<u>Writing</u>

This term we will be focusing on functional and imaginative writing, introducing a drawing club within the creative zone. This will encourage the children to write independently using their imaginations and well-known fairytales as a stimulus. Reading

We will continue to build on our blending skills through our weekly or by-weekly reading books, developing our comprehension skills. Reading tasks will also continue in class to improve our core reading skills, including read to write tasks.

Listening and Talking

During whole class and small group activities the children will be encouraged to show the skills associated with good talking and listening. The children will continue to share their adventures with our class bear. These sessions will encourage all children to display and promote the skills of good talking and listening and develop their confidence in speaking to larger groups.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Practise writing common words to aid retention and increase confidence in independent writing.
- Continuous revision of taught phonemes.
- Draw attention to print and texts in the environment.
- Read for pleasure as often as possible.
- Remember to read the books that are sent home regularly and ensure they are sent to school every day.

Numeracy

This term we are focusing on money, recognising coins and addition and subtraction of monetary amounts to 10p and beyond for some. We will consolidate addition and subtraction to 10 and beyond for some and counting within 100 in a variety of ways

Maths

We will begin to explore data handling, looking at pictograms, tally marks, Venn diagrams and Carroll diagrams. Further to this, we will introduce symmetry and fractions up to $\frac{1}{2}$. We will also work on o'clock timings on analogue and digital clocks and following directions.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Explore and discuss the different coins used and draw attention to prices and amounts when out and about.
