Learning Overview

Literacy

Writing

This term we are focusing on creating persuasive texts such as leaflets, posters and letters. We will learn the purpose of the persuasive genre and techniques to help engage our audience for example using emotive language. We will learn to include a variety of punctuation in our writing such as inserting commas in a list, question marks and exclamation marks. Through weekly handwriting lessons we will focus on ensuring consistent letter size and height to enable us to present our writing in a way that will make it legible and attractive to our audience. We will continue to focus on weekly spelling rules and new common words. During our grammar lessons, we will explore using the comparative and the superlative, alphabetical order and proofreading sentences.

Reading

This term we will continue to use "Reading with Wilbur" and weekly library visits as a tool for promoting reading for enjoyment. In class we will focus on the skills and strategies used for both recalling and summarising the plot of a book. We will also be looking at our in class texts for connections between our lives and the books we read.

Listening and Talking

During whole class and small group activities the children will be encouraged to show the skills associated with good talking and listening. The children will have the opportunity to share their likes/dislikes etc during weekly 'Me in a Bag' sessions as well as sharing their adventures with our class bear. These sessions will encourage all children to display and promote the skills of good talking and listening and develop their confidence in speaking to larger groups.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Encourage your child to read a variety of different texts at home.
- Access Nessy Online at home,
- · Encourage your child to write in a variety of situations such as birthday cards, thank you notes and shopping lists.

Numeracy

We are focusing on counting and ordering numbers up to 100 and beyond. The children will revisit calculations using all 4 operations. During our Big Maths sessions, we will be focusing on doubling 2 digit multiples of 10, finding half of 3,5,7, and 9, in addition to counting in 10s and 5s from 0 to 100.

Maths

We will be learning to recognise and identify a range of 2D shapes and 3D objects. Children will focus on using mathematical language to describe properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects e.g.: side, base, edge. We will create 3D objects using 2D shapes. Furthermore, we will use our knowledge of 2D shape to explore and identify tiling patterns in the environment.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Complete Sumdog and Nessy Number sessions at home.
- Look for shapes and patterns in the outside environment.
- Encourage your child to look for number in their environment

Learning Across the Curriculum

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term we will be looking at our life in Scotland and comparing it to the country of Spain. We will look at the flags, cities and geography of these countries. In addition to learning some simple Spanish words and phrases. The children have spoken about wanting to try famous Spanish food!
