Literacy

Writing

In writing this term we are learning to write independently and use punctuation as well as a joining word in our writing. The text that we will be exploring this term is 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. Our writing will build on our knowledge of our letter formation, sentence structure and grammar.

Reading

In reading we are learning how to use our knowledge of sounds, sight vocabulary and punctuation to read our text. We are reading our reading books each day in class. We will use the illustrations to help guide our reading and decode unfamiliar vocabulary. As we are reading, we will work on adding expression, taking note of punctuation in our text.

Listening and Talking

We are learning how to respond when engaging with others. We are developing in our listening skills of knowing when and how to listen, how much we should contribute and how to respond respectfully to others.

Numeracy

In numeracy we are learning about whole numbers. We are exploring the formation, order and sequence of numbers to 20 and we will be able to use our knowledge of whole numbers to explain the link between its digit, place and its value. Through daily number talks sessions, we are able build on our counting skills going forwards and backwards. We are able to discuss strategies used to help us reach an answer and solve simple calculations.

Maths

This term we will be exploring simple 3D objects and 2D shapes. We will be able to identify, name and describe their features using appropriate vocabulary.
