Literacy

Writing

This term we will be creating texts by selecting appropriate genre, form, structure and style. We will be using a stimulus to produce a narrative piece of writing which will be read to primary one buddies as well as writing a creative piece for P7 classmates to enjoy. We will be looking at uplevelling our writing using a thesaurus and writing sentences of different lengths and types. During daily writing tasks, the children will develop their grammar, handwriting and spelling skills which will extend into their writing sessions.

Reading

During reading, the children will respond to literal, inferential and evaluative questions and other close reading tasks and will create different types of questions independently. We will start this term by reading 'Wonder' by R.J. Palacio as our class novel. Comprehension and reading skills will be developed throughout, including inference, skimming and scanning. Children will be encouraged to read clearly with expression to develop fluency and tone.

Listening and Talking

The children will be involved in a listening and talking project with Cathkin High English department that will work on developing a variety of skills such as pace, gestures and effective use of voice. Details to follow. We will also be discussing our class reader, responding to others' thoughts and opinions.

How can I support my learner at home?

- We are encouraging reading for enjoyment as a school, so please support your child to read.
- Practise spelling through the Google Classroom.
- Log on to Nessy Spelling and Reading.

Numeracy

This term we will solve problems using a range of methods, sharing our approaches and solutions with others. We will start the term revising place value and rounding numbers, so we become confident in applying our knowledge to calculations. We will be developing our mental agility through a range of activities including choral counting and practical tasks.

Maths

In Maths, through practical activities, we will show our understanding of the relationship between 3D objects and their nets. We will draw 2D shapes and make representations of 3D objects using an appropriate range of methods.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Encourage your child to access Sumdog.
- Practise multiplication facts.
- Practise counting forwards and backwards in 10s, 100s, 1000s, 10000s, 100000s using different starting numbers such as 294, 1294, 2294 etc.
