Literacy

Writing

This term our writing block is based on 'Troll Swap'. This unit will focus on sentence structure, character descriptions, adjectives and developing imaginative writing. Letter formation will continue to be a focus this term in handwriting. Children will focus on alphabetical order, sentence writing, speech marks, proper nouns, questions, exclamation marks and commas in lists.

Reading

Reading books continue to go home this term and children read in class each day as well as completing activities related to their current book. Children will visit the school library once per week.

Listening and Talking

Pupils have lots of opportunities to take part in talking and listening activities. This includes class discussions, circle time and during our health and wellbeing PATHS sessions.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Continue to read each night with your child and for children to write down the main ideas of the text.
- Continue to work on letter formation, sound and common word recognition.
- Have a family discussion about seed dispersal and the area of Cambuslang as a community.

Numeracy

This term we are revising our numbers to 100. This includes counting, ordering, sequencing and number formation. We are also exploring odd and even numbers, greater than and less than and skip counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Maths

Our Mathematics focus this term will be 2d shapes and 3d objects alongside units of measure. Children will take in practical activities to enhance their learning experience.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Continue to use Sumdog / Nessy and work on number formation.
- Times tables practise of 2x, 5x and 10x table.
