Literacy

Writing

This term P7B will be creating text selecting appropriate genre, form, structure and style. They will be using a stimulus to produce a narrative piece of writing which will be read to their primary one buddy. They will be looking at uplevelling their writing using thesauruses and writing sentences of different lengths and types. They will then continue their writing using Pathways to Write. During daily writing tasks, the children will develop their grammar, handwriting and spelling skills which will extend into their writing sessions.

Reading

During reading the children will respond to literal, inferential and evaluative questions and other close reading tasks and will create different types of questions independently. Primary 7B will start this term by reading "Wonder" by R.J. Palacio as our class novel. There will be comprehension tasks and reading skills developed throughout, including summarising/paraphrasing, inference, skimming and scanning. They will be encouraged to read clearly with expression and develop fluency and tone.

Listening and Talking

Primary 7B will be engaging with others, responding in ways appropriate to their roles during our listening and talking sessions. We will be discussing our class reader, developing our eye contact and responding to other's thoughts and opinions. They children will also be involved in a listening and talking project with the Cathkin High English department that will work on a variety of skills such as pace, gestures and eye contact.

How can I support my learner at home?

- We are encouraging reading for enjoyment as a school, so please support your child to read each day at home.
- Practise spelling through the Google Classroom.
- Log on to Nessy Spelling and Reading.

Numeracy

This term, Primary 7B will solve problems involving whole numbers using a range of methods, sharing my approaches and solutions with others. We will start the term revising place value and rounding numbers to be confident applying our knowledge to calculations. We will be developing our mental agility through a range of activities including choral counting and practical activities. Primary 7B will also work on their jotter layout for a variety of different word problems.

Maths

In Maths, through practical activities, Primary 7 will show their understanding of the relationship between 3D objects and their nets. They will draw 2D shapes and make representations of 3D objects using an appropriate range of methods.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Encourage your child to access Sumdog (login provided in Home Learning Jotter).
- Practise Time Tables regularly
- Practise counting in 10s, 100s, 1000s, 10000s, 100000s using different starting numbers such as 294, 1294, 2294 etc

We have started our WW2 topic which P7 have been introduced to the historic events that led to the outbreak of the Second World War. P7 have started to place events on a timeline that will grow throughout the topic and build an understanding of the chronology of the war.
