### Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope everyone had a wonderful holiday last week. The children have had a fantastic first week back and are thoroughly enjoying all the new resources in our playground. ### West Coats Parent Council Halloween Disco

Our Parent Council are hosting Halloween Discos on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> October. The P1-3 disco will run from 6.15pm – 7.15pm and the P4-7 disco will run from 7.30pm – 8.30pm. Tickets can be purchased via ParentPay and will be issued via pupil post. Please see below for entry and exit arrangements.

# P1-7 Entry Arrangements

- Children with a purchased ticket will enter through the fire exit doors at the main reception area.
  There will be a bucket for them to place their ticket in, which should help speed up entry. We will then tick off their names on the register.
- Children without a ticket will enter via the bubble at the main entrance and purchase their ticket on entry.

## P1-3 Exit Arrangements

- At the end of the disco, children will go to classrooms in the upper corridor: P1 to Room 14, P2 to Room 15, and P3 to Room 16.
- Parents or carers will enter via the main entrance and can then collect their children from these classrooms and will exit via the classroom cloakroom door, which leads out to the back lane of the upper playground.

# **P4–7 Exit Arrangements**

- At the end of the disco, children will remain in their class groups, and parents or carers can come into the hall to collect them.
- P6 and P7 children who have permission to walk home may do so. We can ask parents to sign the back of the ticket to indicate this.

# **Parking and Drop-Off**

We appreciate that parking may be tricky, but we will rely on parents to park safely and considerately. The janitor will leave the Douglas Drive gate open. For P1–3 parents, we suggest dropping off on the West Coats Road side and collecting from the Douglas Drive side, walking through the back lane to the front entrance. We hope it will be a dry evening, and that many families will choose to walk.
