Literacy

Writing

This term our focus is on the story of 'The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark' by Jill Tomlinson. Our writing will build on our knowledge of adjectives and how to up level our sentences by including connectives. We will be creating fact files, using information about owls and then applying this knowledge to create fact files on other species.

Reading

We are continuing to read our reading books each day in class. We are developing our comprehension skills and being able to make inferences about our texts. We are also encouraging children to make predictions about texts, create their own questions and summarise their reading.

Listening and Talking

This term we are building on our presentation skills to deliver information in a clear manner with expression.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Continue to read group reading book at home during the week.
- Continue to encourage your learner to read for pleasure.
- Explore Nessy and the spelling activities and on Sumdog spelling

Numeracy

In numeracy we are building on our number knowledge of numbers to 1000. We are exploring place value with hundreds, tens and ones. We will then apply our addition skills to solving calculations using the column method.

Maths

We will be looking at symmetry this term and what makes a shape symmetric or asymmetric. We will move onto learning about angles, discussing compass points, directions and identifying a right angle.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Continue to practice addition and subtraction skills
- Continue to build on times table knowledge
- Encourage use of Sumdog and Nessy numbers.
