Literacy

Writing

This term we are writing recounts and adapting imaginative stories based around our class novel *The Nothing to See Here Hotel*. Our main areas of development are increasing the content of our writing, including interesting adjectives, beginning to use speech marks in direct speech and starting our sentences and paragraphs with varied time connectives.

Reading

As a class, we are reading *The Nothing to See Here Hotel*. The Owls and Eagles are focussing on the skills of retrieval using skimming and scanning. The Flamingos and Peacocks are focusing on vocabulary and prediction. The class will be learning how to use Google Forms to complete some comprehension tasks and are enjoying using technology within their literacy activities. If your child is no longer bringing a reading book home, then please encourage them to read for leisure and pleasure. All children are welcome to borrow any books from our school or class library at any time.

Listening and Talking

This term Primary 3 will be taking the lead in our nativity performance. Look out for any lines that have to be practised coming home. We will be working on projecting our voices with expression and working with an audience.

Numeracy

We will be focusing on addition and subtraction within 3 digits this term, using the mathematical language of add, addition, plus, more than, altogether, subtract, minus, takeaway, how many less, how many more than, difference between, how many left.

Maths

The class will be learning about money, using terms such as money, coins, value, change, notes, pound(s), pence, buy, penny, price, cost, buy, sell, spent, pay, expensive (dear), cheap(er/est), less, more, total, worth, cash, cheque, credit, debit card.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Talk to your child about the difference between silver and bronze coins.
- Encourage them to help generate a shopping list within a set budget.
- Encourage your child to try out new games under the Class Learning tab on Google Classroom.
- Encourage your child to quickly recall addition facts within 20. E.g. $3+4=?$ $11+2=?$
