## Literacy

### Writing

This term, we are continuing to apply previously taught techniques, including adjective and adverb phrases, to all areas of writing. We will be focusing on persuasive writing, specifically looking at fact and opinion. Children will continue to have free writing opportunities and handwriting sessions.

### Reading

We are reading "Euro Spies" by Lindsay Littleton as our class novel for pleasure and modelling fluency, phrasing and expression. With our group reading books, we will be continuing to focus on fluency and phrasing, as well as developing our inferential skills, and metalinguistics (understanding the vocabulary used by the author).

### Listening and Talking

We will be continuing to develop our questioning skills, concentrating on inferential and evaluative questions. We will be focusing on presenting skills, particularly pace, eye-contact and content. We will be preparing a talk for the class about hobbies/interests with these skills as a focus.

### How can I support my learner at home?

- Reading for pleasure through a variety of texts including books, comics, magazines and audio books.
- Encourage your child to discuss their day and how they are feeling about their learning.
- Practise spelling through the Google Classroom.
- Practise handwriting with a focus on letter formation and join.
- Login to Nessy (Spelling and Reading) and Sumdog for Literacy-based tasks (spelling and grammar).

## Numeracy

We will be continuing to use the VCPA approach (Verbal, Concrete, Pictorial, Abstract) to developing previously taught concepts to secure learning, specifically in multiplication and division. We will continue to develop skills using fractions, decimals and percentages and introduce the topic of money.

## Maths

We will be investigating length, perimeter and area, along with probability, as well as revising previously taught concepts in time to consolidate learning.

### How can I support my learner at home?

- Please practice times tables at home.
- Encourage your child to access Sumdog (login provided in Home Learning Jotter).
- Access online resources such as [www.topmarks.co.uk](http://www.topmarks.co.uk) to further develop rapid recall.
- Access Google Classroom for links previously used in class to continue learning at home.
