Literacy

Writing

Children will continue to follow their spelling programmes and use their previous knowledge of their phonics and spelling strategies to spell most used words correctly. This term the children will continue to follow the CYPIC Literacy programme. This programme encourages all learners to check over their work and to highlight all punctuation and read over their writing to ensure it makes sense. Reading

As a class we will continue to read Llama out Loud by Annabelle Sami. Using both fiction and non-fiction texts the children will complete comprehension tasks with a particular focus on inference questions. All children have opportunities to explore and choose books from our class library. They are welcome to borrow any books from our class library at any time. All children can bring a book from home to keep in class for reading with Wilbur time.

Listening and Talking

This term we will continue to focus on the skills associated with good talking and listening. Through 'Me in a bag' or personal presentations on a particular subject.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Complete Nessy / Sumdog spelling sessions
- Read aloud with your child.
- Using active literacy strategies work on your spelling and common and tricky words.
- Play board or online games that are literacy focused e.g. scrabble, wordle.

Numeracy

This term P4k will be focusing on ways in which data can be collected and the variety of ways it can be presented in Information Handling. Using the VCPA approach (Verbal, Concrete, Pictorial, Abstract) we will learn strategies and apply them in solving number problems. We will also revisit all known times tables and recap on previous taught concepts.

Maths

This term P4K will be focusing on shape where we will explore a variety of 2D & 3D shapes while identifying their name, properties and features We will also learn about angles and symmetry; we will use a variety of methods to describe and record directions and use vocabulary associated with these concepts. In information handling we will explore ways in which data can be collected and the variety of ways it can be presented.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Access Sumdog tasks as regularly as possible.
- Look for 2D shapes around your house or in the environment
- Complete a survey of their choice and collate and present the data.

Our Interdisciplinary learning will be based around a comparison study between Scotland and South America. We will focus on lifestyles, home life, weather, the environment and foods.
