## Literacy

### Writing

This term we will be creating a range of texts such as newspaper reports and letters. We will have a particular focus on editing our work to improve presentation, spelling accuracy and clarity of writing. Our grammar focus will be using parentheses and exploring irregular nouns, verbs and comparative words.

### Reading

This term we are reading 'Euro Spies' by Lindsay Littleton as our class novel chosen by the pupils. During taught reading sessions children will continue to focus on fluency and pace while engaging in a variety of tasks to develop their reading skills through summarising, comprehension, inferencing and metalinguistics. We will continue our morning 'Reading with Wilbur' sessions to promote reading for enjoyment.

### Listening and Talking

This term Primary 5 will complete a solo talk about an interest they have in front of an audience. We will focus on eye contact, pace and volume, as well as listening to others and asking appropriate questions.

### How can I support my learner at home?

- Practise spelling posted on Google Classroom weekly.
- Read for pleasure using a variety of different texts including books, comic books and audio books.
- Practise handwriting with a focus on size and letter formation.

## Numeracy

We are continuing to develop our mental agility by focusing on the four operations, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. This term we are building our confidence when working with money including calculating totals spent and working out change, using taught addition and subtraction strategies. The children will solve problems using real life scenarios such as comparing costs of items to determine affordability.

## Maths

In maths we are exploring measure. We are learning to read and record a variety of scales and measuring devices including those with decimals. The children will convert between different units of measure.

### How can I support my learner at home?

- Play the different games shared on Google Classroom
- Daily Sumdog
- Practise quick recall of multiplication and division facts.
- Practise using money when paying for shopping using coins and notes to make totals.
- Use different measuring devices to cook or bake at home.

## Learning Across the Curriculum

### Interdisciplinary Learning

This term our focus will be studying Social Enterprise alongside P5/4.

### Wider Learning –

We are continuing to take part in the FUNdamentals of Music project and are making great progress with keyboard and percussion instruments. The children should be participating in a small performance for parents, date to be confirmed.
