Literacy

Writing:

This term, we will continue to focus on imaginative texts, recount writing and creating lists. Reinforcing that their sentences must include capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will also continue to work on our handwriting reinforcing the correct route, shape and size of both upper- and lower-case letters. We will focus on weekly spelling words and common words. We will be focussing on verbs, adverbs, adjectives, alphabetical order and plurals in our grammar lessons.

Reading:

We will continue to promote the skills of good reading during class within small reading groups and child led reading circles as well as time promoting, 'Reading with Wilbur' and reading for enjoyment. Children can bring in a book from home to keep in their tray to read during this time. The children will also complete a weekly reading task associated with their book that promotes skills such as find it, prove it, talk about it, sentence structure and comprehension skills.

Listening and Talking:

During whole class and small group activities the children will be encouraged to show the skills associated with good talking and listening. The children will continue to share their likes/dislikes etc and their favourite books during our weekly class sessions of 'Me in a Bag' and 'Class Reader.' These sessions will encourage all children to display and promote the skills of good talking and listening and develop their confidence in speaking to larger groups.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Encourage your child to read at home each day.

Numeracy

We will continue to recognise and form numbers correctly from 0 up to 100 and beyond. During daily Big Maths sessions, we will focus on reading three-digit numbers, quick recall of number bonds within 10, addition and subtraction within 20 as well as counting to 100 and doubling 2-digit multiples of 10. We will use both vertical and horizontal strategies to complete addition and subtraction sums.

Maths

In Maths we will be learning to recognise and name coins and notes up to £20 and beyond. We will be using a variety of notes and coins to pay for items and give change. We will continue to focus on our 2,3,4,5,6 and 10 x tables and link it with repeated addition. We will be looking at extending our knowledge of time and will focus on telling the time using half and quarter past and quarter to times in both analogue and digital times.

How can I support my learner at home?

- Sumdog Sessions
- Look for and use items around the house and in the environment to tell the time.
- Online activities for x tables recall.
- Encourage your child to count forwards and backwards in 2's, 3's, 4's, 5's and 10's
- Encourage your child to count out money to pay for items and to recognise and calculate amounts for items.
